**SURVEY**

**OF INCIDENTS, EVENTS AND INTELLIGENCE OF SECURITY  
SIGNIFICANCE RECORDED IN THE PERIOD 0600 HOURS ON 15 APRIL  
TO 0600 HOURS ON 16 APRIL 1999**

**1. ATTACKS BY NATO ARMED FORCES**

At about 1220 and 1300 hours on 15 April 1999, NATO aggressor forces bombed the area very close to the village of Vrelo, Lipljan municipality, with two projectiles. The consequences are not known.

Between 1055 and 1115 hours on 15 April 1999, in Kosovska Mitrovica, NATO aggressor forces bombed depot no. 2 in the barracks with five projectiles, and caused considerable material damage. There were no other consequences.

On 15 April 1999 a Peć SUP /Secretariat of the Interior/ investigations team determined the level of damage in the MUP /Ministry of the Interior/ accommodation facility in the VJ /Yugoslav Army/ barracks compound, caused by the bombing carried out at about 0300 hours. It was established that the roof of the building had been completely destroyed, and also that damage had been caused to several dozen houses near this facility.

At about 1230 hours on 15 April 1999, in the villages of Šilovo and Poneš, Gnjilane municipality, and in Veliko Ropotovo village, Kosovska Kamenica municipality, NATO aggressor forces fired four projectiles. There were no casualties, but major material damage was caused to buildings.

At about 1000 and 1040 hours on 15 April 1999 NATO aggressor forces bombed the area of the Čabrat hill – the VJ repeater, Đakovica municipality, with four projectiles. There were no consequences.

On 15 April 1999, members of the police from the Đakovica SUP conducted another search in the Meja village sector, where a refugee column had been bombed on the previous day. Another four people who had been killed were discovered. Ram MALJOKU /MALOKU/ ✓ (1913) and Arton MALJOKU ✓ (1980) were identified, both from Junik village, Dečani municipality.

## 2. Terrorist Attacks

On 14 April 1999, for a period as yet undetermined, a terrorist attack was mounted on positions of the VJ and security workers at the Belačevac opencast mines in Donji Grabovac village, Kosovo Polje municipality. The attack was responded to, and there were no consequences.

On 15 April 1999, during an operation to break up terrorist groups, Dragan PAVLOVIĆ (1969) ✓, a police officer of the Jagodina SUP, was killed in Petraštica village, Štimlje municipality. /handwritten: /?Priština//

Between 0045 and 0145 hours on 15 April 1999, in Stari Trg, Kosovska Mitrovica municipality, a terrorist attack was mounted on the PO /police station/ from the direction of Melenica village. There were no consequences.

At about 1100 hours on 15 April 1999, in the area of Donji Poklek village, Glogovac municipality, a terrorist attack with a hand-held launcher was mounted against members of the VJ. Staniša PUZOVIĆ OF Raška was killed, and serious physical ✓ injuries were sustained by Ljubiša ARANDELOVIĆ (1949) of Vrnjačka Banja, Petar MRVIĆ (1947) of Ruma, Vukašin JANIČIJEVIĆ (1956) of Baljevac, Raška municipality, and Dušan PETROVIĆ (1972) of Raška, all VJ members.

On 15 April 1999 /?Hazi/ LJALJOŠ, of Stevana Tunića Street no. 25, Prizren, reported to the Prizren Secretariat that a terrorist attack had been made on his house during the night, by an explosive device being thrown into the yard, causing minor material damage to buildings. There were no other consequences.

On 15 April 1999 Abdulah SALAUKA filed a report with the Prizren Secretariat about a terrorist attack on his house in Prizren at Milivoja Radivojevića Street no. 1, by an explosive device being thrown into the yard, causing minor material damage. There were no other consequences.

At about 0800 hours on 15 April 1999, in Rznić village, Dečani municipality, members of the police who were travelling in an official vehicle towards the hamlet of Dodić hit an anti-tank mine planted by Šiptar /Albanian/ terrorists. Pero MIROSAVLJEVIĆ sustained serious, life-threatening injuries, and Dragan BOGDANOVIĆ sustained minor physical injuries. Both are Sombor SUP police officers.

### 3. Serious Criminal Offences Committed

On 15 April 1999 Turkan ĐIGOLI /GJIGOLLI/ of Banjska Street no. 1, Prizren, reported to the Prizren Secretariat that during the night unknown persons had committed the criminal offence of aggravated theft from his house, with a number of household items being stolen from him.

On 15 April 1999 the Prizren Secretariat filed a criminal report against Ivica NOVAKOVIĆ (1970) of Suva Reka, for the criminal offence of aggravated theft under Article 166 of the KZRS /Criminal Code of the Republic of Serbia/, because of reasonable grounds for suspicion that he had illegally taken a large quantity of technical goods from the house of Ramadan BEKTEŠI /BEKTESHI/ on 4 April 1999.

### 4. Other

At about 0900 hours on 15 April 1999, at Cetinjska Street no. 29, Kosovo Polje, while houses were being inspected following a bombing, the dead body of Adem ĆEHAJ √ /QEHAJ/ was discovered in the yard of his house. The body was taken to the ISM /Institute of Forensic Medicine/ for autopsy. He was most likely killed by the bombing. The dead body of Šaban /Shaban/ BAJRAMI (1929) was found at Kruševačka Street no. 39, and the body was transferred to the ISM for autopsy. BAJRAMI was most probably killed in the bombing. √

At about 1230 hours on 15 April 1999, in Donji Vidomirić village, Kosovska Mitrovica municipality, there was a careless explosion of a projectile by a soldier in a column of VJ vehicles, which injured Dragomir PEROVIĆ (1963), of Prelez village, Zubin Potok municipality, and Slavoljub RADOVIĆ, (1968), of Kamenica village, Leposavić municipality, both members of the VJ reserves.

At about 1400 hours on 15 April 1999, Šehrije /Shehrije/ VOJVODA (1964) of Lauša village, Srbica municipality, and her five children aged between three and 15, were admitted to Kosovska Mitrovica Health Centre, all having been injured in the legs by firearms during the morning, in the Šatrović quarter of Lauša village.
