4. – SITUATION IN THE TERRITORY

ŠTS /Šiptar /Albanian/ terrorist forces/ did not attack while the 37th mtbr was engaged in an approach march.

5. – ACTIVITIES AND SITUATION IN THE UNIT:

5.1. – Activities

During the day, the unit was engaged in securing roads and inspecting the territory, in accordance with the task of the joint command for KiM /Kosovo and Metohija/. The same day the intake of the rest of the mobilised forces was carried out and they were accommodated in line with the task (task received at 1000 hours on 3 April 1999). Unit redeployment areas are specified in the report strictly confidential no. 119-1 of 3 April 1999.

5.2. Situation

Recruit Aleksandar KOLAKOVIĆ sustained a self-inflicted entry-and-exit wound in the left foot in the redeployment area of the PVO /anti-aircraft defence/ and /artillery rocket battalion/ at about 0830 hours. He was treated at the health centre in Kosovska Mitrovica and his life is out of danger.

State of morale is stable and unchanged.
Security situation is stable.

6. Logistics support.

Logistics support meets the unit's needs to carry out tasks in the territory of KiM.

8. Main tasks for next day

Secure roads and combat control of the territory as set out in the decision of the joint command for KiM.
