Report on the situation in Glogovac

TO THE PrK /Pristina Corps/ COMMAND
(to the Commander personally)

When the b/d /combat operations/ with the ŠTS /Šiptar /Albanian/ Terrorist Forces/ started, a large number of the civilian population from the surrounding villages found refuge in the town of Glogovac.

They included women, children and old people.

The town has no electricity /and/ water for a long time period.

The stocks of food for the population are dwindling.

There is no possibility of providing medical care to the civilian population.

The government organs have not functioned in the town for over a year; the president of the Glogovac SO /Municipal Assembly/ Dobrosav RADOVIĆ, the deputy and vice-president of the Glogovac SO, Mile VUKSANOVIĆ are both in Kosovo Polje or in Zubin Potok, they have moved all the municipal archives to Kosovo Polje.

Because of all of the afore-mentioned, there is a danger of the occurrence of infectious diseases and epidemics among the civilian population.

Due to the vicinity to the units' deployment, infectious diseases may spread to the members of the 37th motorised brigade.

I hereby propose that:

1. Representatives of the Red Cross arrive to assess the situation and provide the most essential assistance in food, water and healthcare.
2. All measures should be undertaken to have the organs of civilian authorities come to Glogovac from Kosovo Polje.
3. if none of the possibilities for providing assistance exists, then an evacuation of the population should be organised.
