of the 36th session of the Serb Republic of BH Government held on 4th July 1992

Chairman of the session was Prof. Branko ĐERIĆ, Government Prime Minister.

Present at the session besides the Government Prime Minister were: Milan TRBOJEVIĆ, Government Deputy Prime Minister, and Prof. Ljubomir ZUKOVIĆ and Božidar ANTIĆ ministers.

Also present at the session were Nedeljko LAKIĆ, Government Secretary, Pero VUJIČIĆ in place of Mićo STANIŠIĆ, Slobodan BELAŠEVIĆ in place of Momčilo MANDIĆ, Zdravko MARINKOVIĆ in place of Petra MARKOVIĆ, Dragiša STANKOVIĆ in place of Nedeljko LAJIĆ, Zdravko MIOVČIĆ in place of Velibor OSTOJIĆ, Slobodan GAJOVIĆ in place of Dr. Dragan KALINIĆ, Momčilo KOVAČEVIĆ in place of Bogdan SUBOTIĆ.

The adoption of the minutes of the 34th and 35th session of the Government.

1. The tasks of the Serb Republic of BH Government which are the outcome of a joint session of the Serb Republic of BH Presidency and the Serb Republic of BH Government held on 1st July.

2. Decree on declaring the Decree on prolonging the validity of the Law on financing general social necessities null and void.

3. Decision on founding a correctional institution in Foča.

4. Decision on products that are considered orthopaedic aids, hearing devices and seeing aids and no sales tax is paid on them.

5. Decision on products that are considered funeral equipment and no sales tax is paid on them.

6. Some questions regarding the introduction of a war regime.

- in the organisation and financing of the Ministry of Information,
- in the sphere of traffic.

7. Decision regarding the appointment of a director to the *Elektroprivreda Bosne i Hercegovine* unified public enterprise.

8. Current issues.

The minutes of the 34th and 35th session of the Serb Republic of BH Government has been adopted in its proposed version.

RE. 1

The Minutes of the joint session of the Serb Republic of BH Presidency and Serb Republic of BH Government held on 1st July 1992 has been adopted in its proposed version. It has been concluded that the Minutes be submitted to the members of the Serb Republic of BH Presidency and the Serb Republic of BH Army Main Staff.

The tasks that result from /as printed/ the Minutes of the joint session have been determined:

1. it has been concluded that the draft bill on the ministries be determined at once based on the text that the Government had considered on the 31st session and on the objections on proposals stated at the session.

Deadline: 5th June.

2. it has been concluded that all ministries propose a general concept on the war regime, as well as the regime on each ministry by Monday (6th July).

Milan TRBOJEVIĆ, Government Deputy Prime Minister is entrusted with coordinating the preparatory work of the general concept.

3. The Ministry of Agriculture is entrusted with immediately proposing the Government regulations that would regulate the following things: what goods can be exported from the territory of the Serb Republic of BH in present circumstances, which are the necessary accompanying documents to be able to export goods, and which organ is authorised to issue the necessary documents.

The authorised organs in the municipalities are entrusted with the above listed regulations to form a commission that would in the present legal and illegal warehouses conduct an inventory of the goods and determine a list of goods that could be sold with the notion that the means from selling goods be allotted into the budget.

4. The Government has concluded that the basic source of financing and supplying the organs that are financed from the budget can only be from the budget obtained in the proper manner and means that are received on an aid basis from foreign countries and other legal ways.

The Ministry of Finance and the Ministry of Economy are entrusted with proposing adequate solutions.

5. The Serb Republic of BH Army Main Staff and the Ministry of the Interior of the Serb Republic of BH are entrusted with, in the spectrum of their authority, to independently and jointly take all measures in controlling the transport of goods, vehicles, travellers, etc.

The Ministry of Finance is entrusted with proposing necessary measures that would ban the payment of wages in cash money.

For this purpose the introduction of vouchers has to be proposed for the purchase of basic provisions with the notion that the difference in LD would be paid in cash money.

For this purpose the experience of the Republic of Serbia in this matter has to be used.

7. The Ministry of the Interior is entrusted with investigating all the cases of illegal actions and property theft and preparing a report on it that the Government and if necessary other republic organs would consider.

RE. 2

The Decree on declaring the Decree on prolonging the validity of the Law on financing general social necessities null and void has been adopted.

RE. 3

The Decision on founding a correctional institution in Foča has been adopted.

On this occasion it has been concluded that the principle in previous consultations be established in the process of appointing judges to courts and appointing prosecutors.

It has also been concluded that the possibility of founding a correctional institution in Sokoc be considered. Prior to that the authorities in Sokoc and Han Pijesak should be consulted on this matter.

RE. 4

The Decision on products that are considered orthopaedic aids, hearing devices and seeing aids and no sales tax is paid on them has been adopted.

RE. 5

The Decision on products that are considered funeral equipment and no sales tax is paid on them has been adopted.

RE. 6

The questions regarding this item of the agenda have been considered in item 1. of the agenda.

RE. 7

The Decision regarding the appointment of Dr. Milorad Skoko to the post of director of *Elektroprivreda Bosne i Hercegovine* united public enterprise has been passed.

RE. 8

The question has been raised whether there are agreed criteria regarding the moving out of the Muslims population from the territory of the Serb Republic of BH.

It has been concluded that the Government has not until now had a point of view on this matter. The Ministry of the Interior is entrusted with preparing

information on this issue that the Government would consider and take the appropriate standpoint.

It has been concluded that the preparations for adopting the budget of the Republic for the 2nd half of 1992 be speeded up.
