

ASSEMBLY OF THE SERBIAN MUNICIPALITY
OF FOČA

PUBLIC ANNOUNCEMENT

In accordance with decisions of the Assembly of the Independent Serbian Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina held in Banja Luka, the Assembly of the Serbian Municipality of Foča concluded as follows:

1. On 7 April 1992 all the organs of the Serbian Municipality of Foča shall become operational.
2. We call upon the Serbian people and other civilians to maintain composure and common sense, not to be taken in by acts of provocation and disinformation, not to move out of the area and to continue conducting regular duties and tasks.
3. Territorial Defence units, together with members of the Public Security Station of the Serbian Municipality of Foča, shall maintain public law and order, ensure protection of people and property and prevent presence of any paramilitary formations in the area of the Serbian Municipality of Foča.
4. The Assembly of the Serbian Municipality of Foča hereby informs the public that it is not opposed to public rallies, but they must be duly announced in accordance with legal regulations.

The Assembly is of the opinion that the “pacifists” demonstration organised in the night between 5 and 6 April caused great unrest among the population, which could have had unwanted consequences.

5. The Assembly of the Serbian Municipality of Foča decided to propose to the partners in the former municipal government to divide and delineate the territory peacefully.
