STANDARD REPORT, No. 50

1. Today the Ustaše were regrouping along the right banks of the Drina and around Vučevo. Certain activities at Zelengora were detected.
2. TG Foča tactical group opened robust artillery fire on Carevo Guvno, Dublje, Humka and Banjača, where an ambush and defence were later organised. Due to the assembling of Ustaše forces, we focused our artillery attacks on the facilities of Trebova Planina, Vrbničke Kolibe (0448), Zamršteni Katun (0450), Palež (0846), Bogunovac Kolibe (1048), Mrčin Kolibe (0850). According to observation and assessments, the Ustaše suffered major losses. Our forces did not suffer any losses.
3. On 01.09, we plan to launch attacks, ambushes and infiltrations from Preljuća and Careva Ravan, in cooperation with TG Goražde, with the objective of breaking down the Ustaše in the Palež area.

4. Requests: An artillery mechanic with a set of tools should be made available to TG Foča. Tomorrow a TG Foča logistics team is visiting Bileća on a special assignment.
5. Special: In the course of 30.08 we released from prison a total of 55 elderly, unfit Muslim males. On 31.08, we released 40 women and children, to keep a visiting commission from discovering them and as an alibi.
The air force did not act according to our requests.
