The winds of war have forced many Foča inhabitants, both Serb and Muslim, to leave their houses and scatter throughout the former Yugoslavia.

Members of families are in Foča, while others are in other towns and cities.

The present civilian and military authorities of the Serbian Municipality of Foča have so far been preventing both Serbs and Muslims from leaving the Foča territory. It is perfectly normal for every family to want to live together, and it is therefore not surprising that the pressure on the civilian and military authorities is mounting every day.

The War Commission has discussed the issue with the government envoy of the BH Serbian Republic and concluded the following:

1. The civilian and military authorities shall allow all loyal citizens who have not violated the laws of the BH Serbian Republic or done anything in this still-ongoing war to endanger the safety of the Serbian people in our area to leave in the direction of their choice.
2. We have learned from statements by Muslim citizens that their leadership has betrayed and abandoned them, which is an additional reason for them to leave the Foča municipality.
3. While respecting the wishes of individual citizens and warning the military and civilian authorities that the lists should not include people unable to leave the territory of the Serbian municipality of Foča for security reasons, the above-named recipients are ordered to make lists, complete with all the necessary data, of those loyal citizens who have expressed a wish to leave, who are to be informed of this decision and are to give a short, signed explanation of their reasons for leaving the municipality.
4. The civilian and military authorities shall, within their capabilities, arrange transportation and appropriate security:
  - a) Public Security Station – physical security;
  - b) Civilian authorities – transportation.
5. The Executive Committee shall draw up a list of property that will remain in Foča, meaning property that cannot be transported under current circumstances.

- Form committees according to the Executive Committee's proposal.
- 6. By means of public address and radio inform the interested citizens of this decision.
- 7. In light of the above carry out all necessary preparations for the full implementation of this decision.
