Transfer of Persons and Goods between the Ljubovija SM /Police Station/ for KPDG
/Border Crossing Control/ and the Bratunac PS /Police Station/ for KDG /Border
Crossing Control/

At 1200 hours on 1 August 1995, a transfer of Muslims who illegally crossed the state border with the FRY /Federal Republic of Yugoslavia/ was conducted at the premises of the Ljubovija SM for KPDG. The following persons were received from members of the Ljubovija OUP /internal affairs organ/ who also debriefed them. The person in question is

1. Ibro KRLIĆ, son of Munib and Hadžiba née Osmanović, born 16 October 1971 in Bektići, Srebrenica SO /municipality/ where he resides, completed elementary school, farmer by occupation, married, father of one, completed compulsory military service. He had a *Beretta* 7.65 mm calibre pistol with one ammunition clip and 5 (five) 7.65 mm calibre bullets.

The aforementioned person, pistol and the ammunition were handed over to members of the Bratunac PS for KDG.
